

POLICY FOR PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

YOUR RIGHTS AS A REGISTERED PERSON

As a registered person you have the right to request access to your stored personal data. However, if the requests are repeated, we are entitled to charge a reasonable fee to administer your request. The request must be sent to SenzaGen AB, Medicon Village, Scheelevägen 2, 223 81 Lund or email info@senzagen.com. As a registered person, you also have the right to demand that we rectify errors and deficiences in your personal data, and you can also request a transfer of your personal data (data portability). In addition you have the right to request that the processing of your personal data be restricted, and you can also demand that it is deleted. You can always object to our processing of your data for marketing purposes. This is done simply by contacting us. As soon as we receive an objection to the use of personal data for marketing purposes, we will immediately discontinue such use.

STORAGE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Your personal information may be stored externally with our IT providers, with whom we have personal data processing contracts. In no other case will we disclose your personal information.

TRANSFERS TO THIRD COUNTRIES

All processing of your personal data takes place within the EU/EEA.
